Students in the Medical Laboratory Sciences Certificate program attend classes on the Storrs campus for 1 semester. The remainder of the time is spent at the clinical affiliate. However during that time, the student is responsible for 2 semesters of full-time tuition and 6 credits of summer tuition.
